Motion: The Newfoundland and Labrador Defense League and the people of Newfoundland and Labrador request that the Parliament of Canada recognize our province as a “Nation within a united Canada”.

An equivalent motion regarding Quebec was ALREADY adopted in the House of Commons on November 27, 2006 by a vote of 266-16. We believe that having once been an independent nation in our own right, the people of Newfoundland and Labrador deserve to be given this designation and acceptance by the Canadian government and by all Canadians.

The word “nation” in this case is controversial but must be understood as “people with a unique culture, history and sense of identity”. The NLDL is not a separatist group and does not advocate separation from Canada.
